76 premis diserbu curi air sepanjang tahun lepas - SPAN

NILAI - Suruhanjaya Perkhidmatan Air Negara (SPAN) menyerbu 76 premis di Negeri Sembilan, Selangor, Johor, Perak dan Melaka kerana pelbagai kesalahan termasuk mencuri air melalui penyambungan saluran tidak sah, sepanjang tahun lepas.

Pengarah Unit Komunikasi Korporat dan Hal Ehwal Pengguna SPAN, Mohd Fazil Ismail berkata, melalui serbuan itu, 97 kompaun dikeluarkan melibatkan RM232,000 dan 22 kes dibawa ke mahkamah untuk pendakwaan.

“

“Premis berkenaan antaranya membabitkan komersial, tapak binaan, ladang ternakan dan kebun. Serbuan dilaksanakan dengan kerjasama pelbagai operator bekalan termasuk Syarikat Air Negeri Sembilan (SAINS), Air Selangor dan Indah Water Konsortium Sdn Bhd.

“Saya yakin jumlah serbuan ini meningkat berbanding tahun sebelumnya susulan aktiviti penguatkuasaan lebih aktif dengan tertubuhnya unit cegah jenayah SPAN dan semakin banyak pihak yang membekalkan maklumat, selain kesedaran orang ramai tentang kepentingan menjaga sumber air,” katanya kepada pemberita di lokasi serbuan di Mantin, di sini pada Rabu.

Mengenai serbuan berkenaan, beliau berkata, dua ladang ternakan lembu dan kambing diserbu di lokasi berasingan kerana didapati membuat penyambungan air secara tidak sah milik SAINS menggunakan paip polietilena berketumpatan tinggi (HDPE) berukuran 25 milimeter.

Mohd Fazil berkata, kedua-dua ladang milik warga tempatan berusia lingkungan 30-an ke 40-an itu dipercayai menggunakan bekalan air berkenaan untuk tujuan aktiviti harian di ladang ternakan masing-masing

Beliau berkata, siasatan juga mendapati kedua-dua premis berkenaan tidak mempunyai akaun bekalan air yang sah berdaftar dengan SAINS dan kesalahan dilakukan di bawah Seksyen 123(1) Akta Industri Perkhidmatan Air 2006 (Akta 655).

“Berdasarkan struktur rumah dan keadaan di sini, kita percaya mereka telah beroperasi melebihi setahun dan ketika serbuan kedua-dua pemilik dipercayai telah melarikan diri. Tindakan akan diambil dan mereka perlu membayar kerugian kepada SAINS selama tempoh air berkenaan digunakan,” katanya.

Dalam pada itu, beliau turut meminta orang awam melaporkan kes berkaitan kecurian air kepada SPAN secara WhatsApp ke talian 013 - 3885000 atau e-mel ke aduan@span.gov.my bagi mencegah kegiatan tidak bertanggungjawab itu. - Bernama

SPAN corporate communications and consumer affairs director Mohd Fazil Ismail said that of the total, 97 compounds were issued, amounting to RM232,000, and 22 cases were prosecuted.

"Among the affected premises are commercial establishments, construction sites, livestock farms, and gardens.

The integrated raid was conducted with the cooperation of various utility companies, including Syarikat Water Negeri Sembilan (SAINS), Air Selangor, and Indah Water Konsortium Sdn Bhd.

"I believe the number of these raids has increased compared to last year following the establishment of the SPAN Crime Prevention Unit, which saw more enforcement activities being carried out, besides information channelled by the public," he told reporters at the raid site in Mantin.

He said two cattle and goat farms were raided today because they were found to be making illegal water connections from SAINS using a 25-millimetre HDPE pipe.

Gangguan bekalan air 48 jam di Seremban bermula 31 Januari

SEREMBAN: Syarikat Air Negeri Sembilan Sdn. Bhd. (Sains) akan melakukan penutupan sementara bekalan air di sebahagian kawasan Seremban dan Kuala Pilah pada 31 Januari sehingga 2 Februari ini.

Syarikat itu menerusi kenyataan memaklumkan, penutupan itu berikutan kerja-kerja penyambungan dan pengalihan paip serta kerja-kerja servis peralatan bervoltan tinggi pada 31 Januari.

Menurut kenyataan itu, penutupan bekalan air selama 48 jam di Seremban itu akan bermula pada pukul 8 pagi, 31 Januari sehingga pukul 8 pagi pada 2 Februari 2023.

Sehubungan itu, jelas kenyataan berkenaan, antara kawasan terlibat yang akan mengalami gangguan bekalan air adalah seluruh kawasan Ampangan, seluruh kawasan Senawang termasuk Paroi, Rasah Jaya, Industri Sungai dan Senawang, Taman Tuanku Jaafar, Bandar Seremban Selatan dan Seremban Jaya.

Turut terlibat, seluruh kawasan Seremban termasuk Bandar Seremban, Seremban 2, Seremban 3, Mambau, Temiang, Templer, Bukit Kepayang, Oakland, Jalan Labu Batu 1 hingga Batu 13, R&R Seremban Arah Utara dan Selatan, Hospital Tuanku Ja'afar, Hospital Columbia, Hospital KPJ, Hospital Mawar dan NSCMH.

Seluruh Sikamat termasuk Taman Desa Rhu, Kampung Ujung Pasir, Taman Warisan Puteri, Kampung Bukit Merbah serta beberapa kawasan tinggi di Mantin dan Lenggeng seperti Taman Bunga Raya dan Kampung Tarun.

"Ia berikutan kerja-kerja penyambungan paip di Kolam Imbangan Batu 5, Seremban dan kerja-kerja servis dan pembaikan peralatan voltan tinggi di Loji Rawatan Air Sungai Terip, Seremban," kata kenyataan tersebut.

Sementara itu, di Kuala Pilah, kawasan terlibat dengan gangguan bermula 8 pagi 31 Januari hingga 8 pagi 1 Februari 2023 itu adalah pekan Senaling, Kampung Maasop, Taman Pilah Senaling, Kampung Batang Pilah, Kampung Sri Pilah, Kampung Ulu Pilah, Kampung Sikai, Kampung Gunung Pasir, dan Kampung Ulu Senaling.

Turut terlibat Kolej Matrikulasi Kuala Pilah, Taman Bahagia Delima, Taman Bukit Intan, Taman Selasih, Kampung Batu 46, Sekolah Zaaba, Sekolah Tunku Kursiah, Taman Pendita, Kampung Bukit Temensu dan Kampung Sungai Layang.

"Penutupan sementara ini berikutan kerja-kerja pengalihan paip S-Bend jenis MS berdiameter 750 milimeter di Kampung Bemban, Kuala Pilah," kata kenyataan itu lagi.

Sains dalam pada itu memaklumkan, penghantaran lori tangki dan penempatan tangki statik merupakan langkah kontigensi yang akan dilaksanakan sekiranya gangguan bekalan air melebihi tempoh penutupan.

"Bekalan air akan disambungkan semula selepas waktu yang dinyatakan dan dijangka pulih secara berperingkat. Bagaimanapun, beberapa kawasan tinggi dijangka akan mengalami tempoh pemulihan yang lebih lama.

"Untuk makluman, kerja-kerja ini merupakan antara usaha Sains dalam menambah baik dan meningkatkan mutu bekalan air demi kepentingan para pelanggan secara berterusan," kata kenyataan itu lagi. -UTUSAN.

48-hour water supply disruption in Seremban, Kuala Pilah from Jan 31

SEREMBAN: Several areas in Seremban and Kuala Pilah will be experiencing water supply disruption, for 48 hours from 8am on Jan 31 to 8am Feb 2, due to pipe connecting and maintenance works.

Syarikat Air Negeri Sembilan Sdn Bhd (SAINS), in a statement, said areas in Seremban which will experience water supply disruption include the Seremban city, Ampangan, Senawang, Paroi, Rasah Jaya, Senawang industrial area, Taman Tuanku Ja'afar, Seremban Selatan, Seremban Jaya, Jalan Ampangan-Kuala Pilah and its surrounding areas.

Other areas affected include Seremban 2 and 3, Mambau, Temiang, Templer, Bukit Kepayang, Oakland, Jalan Labu Batu 1 to Batu 13, Seremban R&R northbound and southbound, Tuanku Ja'afar Hospital, Columbia Hospital, KPJ Hospital, Mawar Hospital and NSCMH Dialysis Centre.

Residents in the Sikamat area, including Taman Desa Rhu, Kampung Ujung Pasir, Taman Warisan Puteri, Kampung Bukit Merbah, Taman Rashibah, Taman Suliana and Taman Penaga, as well as some high areas in Mantin and Lenggeng, will also be affected.

Meanwhile, in Kuala Pilah, the affected areas include Pekan Senaling, Kampung Maasop, Taman Pilah Senaling, Kampung Batang Pilah, Kampung Sri Pilah, Kampung Ulu Pilah, Kampung Sikai, Kampung Gunung Pasir and Kampung Ulu Senaling.

Also involved are Kuala Pilah Matriculation College, Taman Bahagia Delima, Taman Bukit Intan, Taman Selasih, Kampung Batu 46, Sekolah Zaaba, Sekolah Tunku Kursiah, Taman Pendita, Kampung Bukit Temensu and Kampung Sungai Layang.

In the meantime, as a contingency measure, SAINS will deliver water tankers and place static water tanks, if the water supply disruption exceeds the estimated closure period.

SAINS menerusi kenyataan memaklumkan penutupan itu berlaku berikutan kerja penyambungan paip di Kolam Imbangan Batu 5, Seremban, servis serta pembaikan peralatan voltan tinggi di Loji Rawatan Air (LRA) Sungai Terip, manakala di Kuala Pilah melibatkan kerja pengalihan paip S-Bend jenis MS berdiameter 750 milimeter (mm) di Kampung Bemban.

"Penutupan bekalan air selama 48 jam di Seremban itu bermula pada 31 Jan (8 pagi) hingga 2 Feb (8 pagi) melibatkan seluruh kawasan Ampangan, Senawang termasuk Paroi, Rasah Jaya, Industri Sungai dan Senawang, Taman Tuanku Jaafar, Bandar Seremban Selatan dan Seremban Jaya, Jalan Ampangan-Kuala Pilah dan kawasan sekitar," menurut kenyataan itu di sini hari ini.

Selain itu, turut terjejas ialah seluruh Sikamat termasuk Taman Desa Rhu, Kampung Ujung Pasir, Taman Warisan Puteri, Kampung Bukit Merbah, Taman Rashibah, Taman Suliana dan Taman Penaga serta beberapa kawasan tinggi di Mantin dan Lenggeng.
